Happy Easter! He is risen!

This week, we read the Resurrection story in Luke 24. We talked about the power of Jesus, and that His sacrifice on the cross payed the cost of our sin! When we consider the person of Jesus – what He claimed and what He did – we see that He did something that no one else could ever do... conquer death!

1. If this is your life group's first meeting or if you have new members, take some time introducing yourselves and getting to know each other!
2. Is there something special or fun that you did over Easter weekend? Was there something that helped you keep Jesus as the One you celebrated?
3. What thoughts and feelings do you think the disciples had on Good Friday and the day after? How about on Resurrection Sunday?
 - What brings you hope when you find yourself unsure of the future? Or when something seems to fall through that you were counting on?
4. Consider this claim: "The foundation of Christianity is the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead." What do you think this means and do you agree? Why or why not?
5. Read 1st Corinthians 15:3-8.
 - Why do you think it's important that there were so many eyewitnesses to Jesus' resurrected state?
6. How does the resurrection of Jesus change how you live today?
7. What are some ways that you've experienced the power of Jesus in your life?
8. Is there anything else from Jesus' life, death, and resurrection or from this week's message that God brought to your attention or that He's been using to help shape you this week?
