



## *Life Group Questions*

*Week of 4/7/24*

We've started a new series called Overheard. We're listening in on conversations that people had with Jesus, and finding that their lives were immediately and permanently changed from meeting Him!

1. This week, we read about Zacchaeus in Luke 19:1-10. Read the passage together.
2. One of Zacchaeus' most well-known traits is that he was short! Have you ever run into any difficulties because of your height?
3. In verse 5, Jesus looks up and addresses Zacchaeus by name. What does this tell us about Jesus? How does this affect how we relate to Jesus?
4. What was the response of the people in the crowd to Jesus going to Zacchaeus' home?
  - Do you relate at all to their thoughts and comments? Have you seen similar responses play out within churches?
  - How can we encourage ourselves and others to see people the same way that Jesus does?
5. In verse 8, Zacchaeus announces some big financial changes he's going to make. Why? What do we think is his motivation?
  - Jesus' interaction with another wealthy man, a rich young ruler, is recorded in the chapter before we read about Zacchaeus. Compare how the two men responded to their conversation with Jesus.
  - When you met Jesus, were there any changes that happened quickly in response to believing in Him?
6. When Zacchaeus met Jesus, his life was changed. Jesus has given believers the Great Commission – to go into all the world and make disciples.
  - Read the following verses: 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 5:20, Matthew 9:37-38, Ephesians 6:19-20, Matthew 5:14-16
  - What are you already doing or what could you start doing to fulfill your mission from Jesus to make disciples?
7. Is there anything else from Luke 19:1-10 or from this week's message that God brought to your attention or that He's been using to help shape you this week?
