



**Week:** Sunday, Mar 10th  
**Text:** John 1:1-18

We started a new series in the book of John this last Sunday at the Naz. As a part of this series we're encouraging the church body to read through the book of John over the next 40 days. Use the weeks leading up to Good Friday to check in with your group on how their solo reading time is going.

Ask: Have you had the opportunity to start reading the book of John? If so, what is the Lord revealing to you?

### **Let's Discuss**

- Words have power. Do you agree?
- Have you ever used your words in a way that has shaped your, or someone else's, day?
- Read John 1:1-18 together.
- What significance is there to John starting with Jesus being described as the Word? (vs 1)
- If He was there in the beginning, what is John telling us about the person of Jesus? (vs 2)
- If nothing was made without Jesus, what power or authority does that give Jesus today? (vs 3)
- How have you experienced Jesus being a source of life in this day and age? (vs 4)
- Has anyone this group ever adopted a child or themselves been adopted? If so what was it like having someone join your family or joining a new family? (If no one in the group has had this experience, imagine together what this would be like.)
- What does it mean for those of us that believe in Jesus to be a part of a new family? Take some time to unpack this. (vs 12)
- Jesus is our Father in spirit, but what comfort can we find in knowing He took on flesh?
- What are some take-aways from the text we discussed today?
- Pray for/with one another.
