- If you're familiar with the Pharisee's motives, how was Jesus' answer to their question both the "right" answer and its meaning for them completely missed?
- How can we use this passage as a sort of test to see what may be clogging the pipeline of Jesus' work in our lives?
- What things do we end up "loving" with our heart, soul, mind, and strength outside of God?
- Why is loving others such a crucial part of moving out of a place of spiritual dryness?
- How can we pray for one another?
