What are the small (or large) animals that run in front of our spiritual cars that can cause us to swerve away from the hope of God in our lives?
- What does verse 23 say to encourage us to not swerve when those things come across our paths?
- Share a story from your own life where you were able to "Hold Tight" on the wheel of life during a difficult circumstance. What anchored you to the Lord's hope?
- How do we take this verse into our walks with Jesus this week?
- Pray this benediction over your group as you close in prayer today:
"May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit" - Romans 15:13
