Living Like Jesus 1 John 2:1-6 & Luke 4:1-14

Since the resurrection of Jesus is a reality, your life can forever be changed. To encounter the risen Savior is to discover a new reality for your life. Because of the resurrection, we can experience the transforming power of Jesus in every aspect of our lives. It is the very plan of God that we would live in relationship with Him and live each day like Jesus. Let's discover how.

1. Live in the affirming love of the Father.

"When all the people were being baptized, Jesus was baptized too. And as he was praying, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended on him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven: 'You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased.'" Luke 3:21-22 (NIV)

2. Live in the presence and fullness of the Spirit.

3. Live in the Father's leadership.

4. Live in the power of the Spirit.
